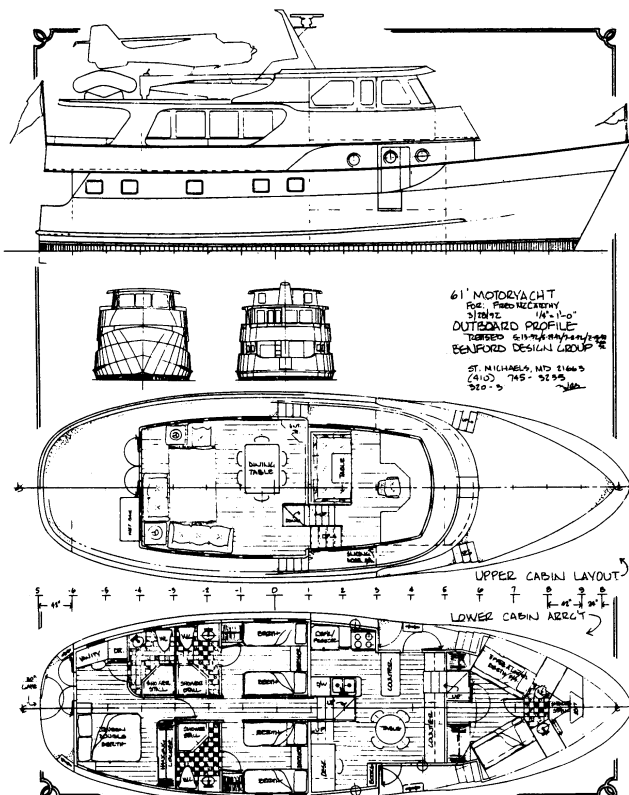

Cruisers & Trawler Yachts

The 62' Trawler Yacht, **Indenture**, (right) has room for living aboard and to have a traveling dentist's office. This work space could be used for quite a number of other uses, too. The owner's stateroom is on deck and there's a smaller stateroom behind the pilot house. Also, the spaces in the hull could be converted for more accommodations if the office space wasn't needed.

The 55' Trawler Yacht, **Lady K**, (left) has a very roomy two stateroom layout for cruising and liveaboard use. There's an extra berth in the pilothouse for occasional use. She's very easily driven and will be economical to own and operate.

The 61' Aircraft Carrier (left) is a steel motoryacht that carries a float plane in addition to the usual small craft on the boat deck. She is laid out with the crew quarters for up to four forward, galley amidships, the saloon up behind the pilothouse, and three good sized staterooms with en suite heads aft for the owner and/or charter party.

The 65' Trawler Yacht (right) has a similar layout to the 61-footer. She too could carry something unusual on her boat deck, or you could keep it open for entertaining. Like our Freighter Yachts, she carries her small craft forward over a cargo hold space.
